Sibelius is the easiest way to produce professional looking scores, and is packed full of features to make the process of realizing your score as quick and transparent as possible. The course will look at the best ways to input your ideas, and will also cover customising of score layout, editing, arranging, part extraction as well as MIDI import. Sibelius is ideal for composers, arrangers, musicians, music directors and teachers and also anyone training to become one of these!

Course Content:

- Choosing & formatting Score Layout
- Inputting notes using MIDI, mouse or keyboard
- Customizing scores: Titles, dynamics, lyrics, expression markings
- Arranging: Copying and moving sections
- Printing scores and extracting individual parts
- Importing MIDI files
- Scanning scores with Photoscore
- Creating an audio CD of the score

All courses are taught in small groups in a professional environment to ensure each delegate will get as much out of the course as possible. The shorter 1 and 2 day courses are designed for delegates to get a basic understanding and practical experience for most essential aspects of the subject. We assume that delegates opting for these courses have little or no knowledge or experience. These courses are therefore taught from basic principles.

The 10 week evening courses allow the delegates to gain a deeper understanding of the underlying principles and concepts behind the technology and its wider applications. Delegates will also have a far more comprehensive practical experience, thereby gaining fluency, accuracy and confidence. Weekly sessions allow the information to be thoroughly assimilated, and give the opportunity to practice techniques and formulate plenty of questions between lessons.
